Membership in the League is open to all persons 18 years or older, both artists and non-artists who are interested in supporting and participating in the visual arts.

Membership is renewed annually on the first of the calendar year by payment of dues and submission of a completed membership registration form.

Individuals joining for the first time may do so anytime during the calendar year by completing a membership registration form and paying the annual dues plus a one-time initiation fee. Membership is not prorated, however those joining in the fall will be in good standing through the next calendar year. An individual whose membership has lapsed for more than two years will be considered applying as a new member.

League of Roanoke Artists
Gallery Participation Contract

The following are guidelines for artists participating in the LRA Galleries.

Eligibility:

Participation is open to all members of the League of Roanoke Artists who are current with dues payment and in meeting the requirements for the Gallery including proper preparation of the art work to be displayed.

Procedure for Exhibition

Each Gallery will have a Gallery Coordinator who will arrange for the display of artwork and scheduling of artists for the space. Some Galleries will require registration for a specific hanging date to accommodate the space and the Business Representative for the Gallery. Participating artists may be asked to assist in hanging of art by the Coordinator.

All work must be appropriate for viewing by the general public and children.

All work must be Gallery ready for hanging at the time of presentation at the Gallery.

Work must be dry, ready for hanging with sturdy, protective framing, and wire attachment placed for appropriate presentation (saw tooth hangers are not acceptable). The art work must have the name of artist, title of work and contact telephone number for the artist on the back of the work. The artist will register all work with the Coordinator, sign specific contracts and complete description cards for all the work.

Although care will be taken, no responsibility is assumed by either the Business Host, the League of Roanoke Artists or the Gallery Coordinator for damages to or loss of exhibited art work. Insurance is the responsibility of the exhibiting artist.

The Gallery Coordinator and the Business Representative reserve the right to refuse or remove any inappropriate work or improperly framed work.

The work must be delivered to and picked up from the Gallery on the designated time.

It is not the responsibility of the Gallery Coordinator to transport, store or otherwise handle the artist work. The LRA Galleries have no storage capabilities. Failure of the artist to meet exhibition requirements can result in being ineligible for future exhibitions. It is the responsibility of the exhibiting artist to handle all sales transactions, payment of sales tax and notifying the Gallery Coordinator of art sales.
